







Use Case: Palm Beach County, FL 2019 PIT Count Survey

Palm Beach County's Challenges

- Disjointed data collection & management
- No confidence in location tracking
- Massive staff time spend on manual entry, cleaning and analysis
- No real-time insights for immediate action
- Inexperienced data collectors



Digital Point In Time Survey Solution





Providing Homeless Populations with Proper Resources

- 200 Citizen Volunteers
- 2 Days
- 6,000 Surveys Completed
- Data Analysis reduced from 3 months to 2 weeks







Immediate Results



Data collection process shrank from **2 Weeks to 1 Day**



Data analysis shrank from **3+ Months to 2 Weeks**



Resource allocation and outreach happened **3 Months Faster**



IMPACT.




Why is this important?

Case Study: Ending Homelessness in Palm Beach County, FL

SITUATION BEFORE PARTNERSHIP WITH DHARMA PLATFORM

- Disjointed data collection (pen, paper) and management processes prone to errors and quality issues
- Difficulties in confidently tracking location of homelessness populations
- Hours of staff time spent manual entry, cleaning and analysis
- Lag time in getting insights from data hindered timeliness and efficacy of PIT count
- Inability to act on insights from data quickly and real-time impact difficult to prove to community and government agencies

SCALE & SCOPE

- 200 data collectors
- 6,000 records over 2 days
- 1 County: Palm Beach, FL.

PROGRAMS & USE CASES

- PIT Count Survey
- Identifying and measuring needs of homeless individuals and families

IMPACT OF THE DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION PARTNERSHIP

- All data instruments in a single, secure, scalable database instance
- Reduced time cleaning and analyzing data and faster time to insight for Palm Beach Country staff

OUTCOME LEVEL

- Data collection and analysis time reduced from 3 months to 14 days
- Greater and faster visibility into realities of homelessness across Palm Beach County



IMPACT LEVEL

- Too early to determine
- Intended impact: improved allocation of community and County resources to end homelessness.
